Dying in Order to Serve

Imagine two grains of wheat lying on the floor of a warm and cozy barn. One day, the farmer comes in and tells them, "I want to take you out of this comfortable barn and plant you in the earth. I'm going to place you in the cold ground and cover you with soil. It will be dark, and you will die. But I promise that you will multiply and become very fruitful."

The first grain of wheat turns down the suggestion. "No way! I'm fine right where I am!" he says. "Count me out. I like my comfort, and I don't want to die." But the second one, after carefully considering the pain and discomfort of dying, decides the promise of a future harvest is worth the sacrifice. So, the farmer takes him outside and plants him in the ground, while allowing the first grain of wheat to remain inside the barn.

A few days later, a small green sprout begins to appear over where the seed has been planted. Then it grows and becomes a tall stalk of wheat that produces one hundred more grains. For the next 45 years, the farmer plants all the seeds that originated from that first grain of wheat, and year after year the harvest multiplies. Meanwhile, the

grain of wheat that stayed in the barn remains there all alone, never growing or multiplying, but he has stayed very comfortable.

In John 12:24-26, Jesus says "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the earth and dies, it remains alone; but if it dies, it bears much fruit. He who loves his life loses it, and he who hates his life in this world will keep it for eternal life. If anyone serves me, he must follow me; and where I am, there shall my servant be also; if anyone serves me, the Father will honor him."

For a seed to germinate and grow to become a crop it must 'die'. Death leads to life. When we "die" to ourselves, we "rise" to new life in Jesus Christ. What does it mean to "die" to oneself? It certainly means that what is contrary to God's will must be "crucified" or "put to death". God gives us grace to say "yes" to His will and to reject whatever is contrary to His loving plan for our lives. Jesus also promises that we will bear much "fruit" for Him if we choose to deny ourselves for His sake.

Jesus knew that the only way to victory over the power of sin and death was through the cross. His cross frees us from the tyranny of sin and death and shows us the way of perfect love.

So, which grain of wheat are you? Are you playing it safe, or have you let Christ plant you in the world? The only way you will become useful and fruitful in God's kingdom is by abiding in Him and trusting that His desires for your life are worthwhile.

Are you familiar with THRED? Paul Schreiber, who reports on the impact of LHM's ministry work in the United States, gives us an update.

THRED is LHM's five years and running social media ministry - a special blend of online videos,

topical blogs, conversational threads, in-depth articles, and several video series.

"Our experience at THRED is that people are seeking intelligent, provocative, spiritually-based social media interactions. They want to engage others in a real-life, real-time conversation where they can share their point of view and not be harshly judged or given pat answers to their complex questions," said Rachel Tic ich, digital development manager for LHM.

"THRED's direction in 2022 and going forward will equip Christians for digital outreach in deep and meaningful ways. Applying what we have learned, we will continue to create fresh content that is timely and grounded in truth. Our goal is and always has been-to inspire and equip Christians to share their faith through winsome digital interactions that lead to vital spiritual conversations." Thich added.

As LHM worked with Barn Group to create and produce The Spiritual Conversation Curve, THRED shifted and grew to connect and align its content and strategies with this exciting philosophy of outreach. From the beginning, THRED's goal has been to connect churched and non-churched people in spiritual conversations. Using the Curve, THRED staff and volunteers began to realize this goal by employing the paradigm of "gaining a hearing," "giving good news," and "guiding towards faith" in their online exchanges.

Expanding on this approach is THRED's current work with Historic, a digital consulting firm which is reviewing THRED's layout and content arrangement.

THRED continues to be a vital component in LHM's goal of "Bringing Christ to the Nations." The world we live in now- and surely

many years to come-will contain the internet, or something like it. LHM's work to develop digital strategies to bring people together online is crucial. People are seeking; people are hurting; people are lost. Sometimes the only place they will go to connect with others is online. If their search takes them to THRED, there's an open and honest conversation about life, faith, and Jesus, waiting for them.

Church Office Closed June 6-10


Campus access that week through Church Narthex



He is Risen, He is Risen Indeed, Hallelujah! Jesus' followers went to the tomb, only to find it empty. The Sunday School found an empty tomb. Actually, they crafted an empty tomb made of a paper plate with an angel overseeing the entrance, complete with a rolled-away stone.


The Resurrection story continues as the children review John Chapter 20, where Jesus appears to "Doubting" Thomas.

It is the afternoon of Jesus' Resurrection, and the children recollect the event of Luke 24, "Jesus appears on the Emmaus road." We read of two men headed from Jerusalem to Emmaus who are discussing the miracle of all time that took place that morning, when Jesus catches up to them and joins them on their journey. It is not until they all gathered together for an evening meal when Jesus took bread, blessed it, and broke it, and giving it to them that they at once recognized Him.

Not only did the children study the time that Jesus appeared to His disciples at the Sea of Galilee (John Chapter 21) but also to identify mothers to sons on Mother's Day. The photo below shows the children matching famous Biblical sons to their Biblical mothers on the white board and on individual handouts. They did a commendable job of matching eight sons to their mothers (do you know the name of Moses' mother)? Speaking of mothers, a new student correctly identified the specific connection between mothers and the Ten Commandments.



To cap off Mother's Day activities the children had the opportunity to color a basket of flowers for their mom and provide written responses to a list of five questions, such as: "I love my mom because," and "My mom is special because." Hopefully all the children presented their handiwork for their moms to cherish and enjoy.
