Feelings of Inadequacy

At one time or another, we have all dealt with feelings of inadequacy. Maybe it's because we lost our tempter with our spouse, missed an important work deadline, or were too afraid to say yes to an opportunity at church. How did you feel afterwards? Maybe you were frustrated with yourself or felt as if you didn't measure up. In 2 Corinthians 2:14-17, Paul asks a question that points to this common insecurity: "Who is adequate for these things?" (2 Corinthians 2:16).

Here's the good news: We are inadequate – but God isn't. And we trust Him as our Lord and Savior, we become His children, and He gives us His righteousness (John 1:12; 2 Corinthians 5:21). He empowers us and has promised to lead us "in triumph in Christ" (2 Corinthians 2:14). But unless we believe Him and step out in faith, we will never experience the life He has planned for us.

Feeling inadequate isn't a sin, but using inadequacy as an excuse is. When God calls us to do something that feels beyond our abilities, we have two choices: We can focus on Christ and proceed in triumph or focus on ourselves and withdraw in defeat.

It's really a matter of faith. God will always empower us to do what He asks us to accomplish. This doesn't mean we will do everything perfectly, but each step of obedience is a victory that He will bless (Psalm 128:1-2).

For example, Paul never said he was capable of doing all that God called him to. He simply learned to look beyond his own inadequacy to the sufficiency of Christ. And if we adopt the same practice, we will be able to discover the blessings hidden in our experiences of inadequacy. So keep in mind:

Our insufficiency should drive us to God. When we realize a situation is bigger than we can handle, we ought to quickly open the Bible and diligently pray for guidance and power. Inadequacy relieves us of the burden of self-effort and self-reliance, motivating dependency on divine power instead.

We will never be adequate until we draw from the Holy Spirit's inexhaustible strength. He does in and through us what God never intended that we do on our own. By using inadequate people, God demonstrates the great things He can do. There is no limit to what He can accomplish through someone willing to give Him full control.

Inadequacy challenges our faith. Paul says, "Our adequacy is from God" (2 Corinthians 3:5). Those who focus on the reliability of this promise and step out in obedience will grow in faith. Let the Lord make you adequate: Rely upon Him and allow Christ to live in and through you.



Thank you to everyone who donated to our food pantry this summer! We are still in need of the following items.


- Tomato Sauce

Petal Pushers® 2025 Rose Parade Float Coloring Contest



Youth Group is Back for Junior High AND High School!


5th-8th grades will meet Wednesdays from 6:00 to 7:30 PM starting Wednesday, September 4. There will be snacks, games, and a Bible study!
