## A Simple Command

The words above from Jesus are some of His final ones spoken to the disciples before His Death on the cross. Jesus gave this command on love while knowing Judas would betray him and soon would be disowned by Peter. While Jesus and His friends were likely feeling anxious, scared, and angry, He chose to speak about love - and not just any love, He provided us with a specific command. A simple task, love another as we have been loved.

Jesus displayed many examples of love throughout his life on earth. His love was shown through His actions and in the way He lived. He served others and did so with a humble attitude. This can be seen in John 13 when Jesus washed His disciples' feet.

There are ways we can show love to others in our daily lives. We can take time out of our hectic schedules to support one another. We can lend a hand to someone in need. We can pray for one another. Acts of true love don't have to be extravagant – they can be as simple as encouraging words or listening.

This February, let us be reminded of Christ's perfect love and the importance of showing love to each other. Remember that true love is selfless and sacrificial. Ultimately, when we show this kind of love to others, we point them to Christ.



# Blessing Our Community: Food Pantry Update

'For I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed me, 3 I was naked and you clothed me, I was sick and you visited me, I was in prison and you came to me.'

Then the righteous will answer him, saying, 'Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you, or thirsty and give you drink? And when did

we see you a stranger and welcome you, or naked and clothe you? And when did we see you sick or in prison and visit you?' Matthew 25:35-39

It's been another busy year at Abiding Savior's food pantry. Over the ten years I've been on our staff, the names and faces have changed, but the need is always there. People affected by job loss or cuts in hours, unexpected illness, or living on a fixed income come to Abiding Savior, where we live the words of Matthew 25:35, handing out bags of groceries to meet the needs of those that come through our doors.

Our food pantry in 2024 (through November 30th) has served thirty-one new clients and eighteen returning clients. Ten of those were homeless food packs and hygiene kits; the remainder were groceries provided to individuals and families that have housing. Each of those families receives two to four bags of groceries, depending on how many people are in the household. The returning clients visited a total of forty-eight times during the year. By December 31st, I expect us to again top 100 total visits for our

Over the last two to three years, we've seen a lot more senior clients. Since the COVID pandemic, we've seen fewer homeless, but more families looking for groceries.

As I prepared the tally, some of the individual stories jumped out at me, some from my memories of their visits, some from my notes detailed in the spreadsheet. The previously homeless client came in last spring for a pantry food box because they'd gotten housing. The clients whose need began with the pandemic, driven by job losses, illness, and reduced hours have gradually stopped coming as they

got back on their feet. The family of Ukrainian refugees newly arrived in the US. The quirks and special requests – the client whose wife loves applesauce, the one whose kid loves ramen noodles, the one that always wistfully asks if we have coffee available. In each notation on my spreadsheet are the human stories behind the statistics.

What is even more amazing is that is just ONE aspect of our congregation's servant's heart. From preparing taxes through VITA, holding the Great Giveaway every year, Operation Christmas Child, Thanksgiving food boxes, Angel Tree, and Spark of Love, our church, school, and preschool never fails to come through when there is a need. Ten extra families for Angel Tree last year? No problem! Pantry running low on food? Not for long! The school PTL collected food during their Fall Carnival this year for our Thanksgiving meal boxes and allowed us to serve ten additional families. Large Print prepares Bibles and copies of the Lutheran hymnal for people in prisons. Each month they prepare several hundred copies of Today's Light, a large print devotional, that goes to a large mailing of people throughout the US.

When the need is inside our church, school or preschool families, I have seen how we all come together in amazing ways to care for those in our midst when there are challenges to be met.

As a member of ASLC, the ASLC VITA tax team will be offering you a waiver on certain requirements that the general public otherwise must meet. Sign up now to get the date and time of your choosing. Please answer all the questions on the form. You will be contacted by a scheduler to set up your date and time. You will then be sent an email to confirm your appointment. There will be attachments to the email for you to fill out and bring to your appointment. Carefully note the list of tax documents you will need to bring with you.

The hours of operation will be Tuesdays 4:00 PM-6:30 PM and Saturdays 9:00 AM-11:30 AM beginning January 28th.

For a "simple" return you may wait for it to be completed as long as volunteers are available.

Please note that your income cannot exceed around \$67,000 to qualify for free tax preparation.

The Abiding Savior team offers you a friendly, caring atmosphere and you can expect 100% accuracy on your return. We abide by ADA guidelines. Our team is certified by the IRS to prepare your returns.
