#### Together in Christ Stephanie Harmon

As believers, we are not meant to walk our life journey alone. Instead, we are called into community, into a shared life of faith where we find encouragement, accountability, and a deeper understanding of God's love through our connection with one another. This can happen in many places - in church, bible study, or life group, your neighborhood, a walking club, and more.

The early church serves as an example to us. The book of Acts paints a beautiful picture of believers: "They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer." Acts 2:42 NIV. Their togetherness wasn't just a social gathering with food, it was a spiritual lifeline, a source of strength in times of trouble. Together, they were a powerful witness to the transforming power of life with Jesus.

Why is this fellowship so critical for us today?

Encouragement and Support:

Let's be real, this life is plain hard. We face trials, insecurities, and temptations all day long. But together in fellowship, we find the comfort of shoulders to lean on, voices that speak truth, and encouraging words. Hebrews 10:24-25 reminds us to "And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching." We are instructed to build one another up and to remind each other of God's promises and the hope we have in Christ.

Accountability: While encouragement lifts us, accountability can help us stay the course. Several church friends continually remind me to trust in God's plan, not my own. Their gentle reminders help me refocus my eyes on Jesus, and I hope to provide them the same. In fellowship, we have relationships that can challenge us, offer words of wisdom, and hold us accountable. This isn't about judgment, but about a loving desire to see each other grow in Christ's love.

Shared Joy and Sadness: Gathering together and sharing our joy is uplifting. At the same time, gathering together in a time of need can be a source of comfort. Sharing life experiences deepens our bonds and serves as an important reminder - we are not alone in our faith walk. Knowing that others are praying and supporting us reminds us of the love of Christ.


I love the book "Holy Hygge" by Jamie Erickson, which offers some fun fellowship ideas for all ages:

### Time To Celebrate!



It was a banner year for VITA, the free income tax service here at Abiding Savior Lutheran Church!

We served well over 200 clients and am pleased to report that the number of Abiding members has increased.

Practically everyone expressed their overwhelming gratitude and appreciation for providing our free service. This is evidenced, in writing, by surveys recorded by a sample of our clients.

Of greater importance was witnessing to these folks as disciples of Christ through intangible service as well as tangible. Examples: One client requested prayer on behalf of her son, who is plagued with mental disabilities that requires being institutionalized in restoration facilities; a prayer for him was brought before the altar the following Sunday. Another client reported that her husband was hospitalized due to a heart attack; a prayer was offered on the husband's behalf; on a follow-up telecon with the client, she reported that a ventilator, in which he was

connected, had been removed.

On another positive note, the number of volunteers who were non-members of Abiding Savior slightly exceeded the member volunteers (considering the volunteers who performed handson preparation, review, and scheduling clients for the final steps of the entire cycle).

Volunteer Income Tax Assistance will resume next year, "If the good Lord's willin' and the creek don't rise!"
